The Bechtel Summit Shakedown is open to 36 registered youth who are qualified on a first come first serve basis. To attend, Scouts must have completed the 6th grade, or will be at least 12 years old and a 1st Class Scout by July 1, 2012, but have not reached their 18th birthday by July 13, 2012. After our troop has been filled, a standby list of alternates will be established. When made available, contingent member will be required to submit a completed High Adventure BSA Medical form signed by a licensed physician and indicating compliance with specified immunizations.

Adult Leadership: Registered adult leaders that wish to apply for one of the four leadership position in the contingent must complete an application. All adult leader applications will be reviewed by the New Birth of Freedom Council High Adventure Committee and adults selected will be notified.
