INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING TO ATTEND THE JAMBOREE

Overview:

The only place where you can apply to attend the 2013 National Scout Jamboree is at the home of the Summit on the Web: www.summitbechtelreserve.org Interested applicants can apply to attend the 2013 National Scout Jamboree as a youth participant or volunteer Jamboree staff. Conditions apply for each of these categories. Please refer to the website above for the latest details. BOY SCOUT QUALIFICATIONS

- Must have a current BSA membership with a Boy Scout troop or Varsity Scout team.
- Must be at least First Class Scouts.
- Must be at least 12 years of age by the first day of the jamboree or an 11 year old that has graduated the 6th grade, but has not reached their 18th birthday by the last day of the jamboree.
- Be approved by the unit leader and local council.
- Participate in a pre-jamboree training experience.
- Have filed a Jamboree Personal Health and Medical record with the council jamboree committee before the pre-jamboree training.

Submit all registration fees per the local council's payment schedule

Who Can Attend:

The National Jamboree is open to all Scouts and Venturers who are qualified on a first come first serve basis. A Scout who has completed the 6th grade, or will be at least 12 years old and a 1st Class Scout by July 1, 2013, but not have reached his 18th birthday by August 3, 2013 and lives and abides by the Scout Oath and Law and the Jamboree code of conduct may participate in the Jamboree. After our five troops have been filled, a standby list of alternates will be established. Scouts will be assigned to a Jamboree troop consisting of 36 Scouts and 4 adult leaders. Each Scout will be a member of a patrol within the troop. Contingent member will be required to, submit a completed National Jamboree Medical form signed by a licensed physician and indicating compliance with specified immunizations, attend a contingent gathering in 2012 and 2013.
