Before You Register For Philmont

Cardiac or Cardiovascular Disease
Hypertension (High Blood Pressure), Insulin Dependent Diabetes Mellitus, Excessive Weight, Seizure, Epilepsy, Asthma, Allergy or Anaphylaxis, Emotional Difficulties, Medication, Special Diets, Ingrown Toenails, Recent musculoskeletal injuries and Orthopedic Surgery

Scout Participants

Scouts must be at least 14 years of age by January 1, 2013, or have completed the 8th grade **AND** be at least 13 years of age prior to participation. All participants are required to have a current physical and meet Philmont's height and weight requirements.

Adult Advisor Selection

Qualified adult candidates will be selected for participation after an interview with members from the Council High Adventure Committee. Anyone interested in an advisor position should submit an application. Note adults will need to complete CPR and Wilderness First Aid Certification.

What's in Included in the fee?

- All meal during trip are included
- All Prep trip activates and lodging
- Shakedown weekend lodging and meals
- All airline transportation
- All Philmont Expedition Fees



Pre Expedition Activities

The crews will depart on June 11, 2013 and fly into Denver, Albuquerque or Colorado Springs. Activities and tours will be planned before your Philmont expedition starts on Tuesday June 13, 2013.

What is not included in fee?

- All equipment including stoves, tents and maps
- All crew weekend conditioning hike expenses.
- All emergency transportation expenses home
- All souvenir and snack money
- All medical exam or medical treatment

Refund Policy

All payments are non-refundable, including refunds requested due to medical conditions, family emergencies and summer school. If a participant drops out and is unable to attend, any payment made may be transferred to a new participant. If this occurs refunds will be issued in October 2013 when all accounts are closed or after we receive credits from Philmont Scout Reservation.

Projected Cost Fees may change due to cost of airfare or lack of participation. Participants agree they will be responsible for additional costs.

Additional Costs Participants should plan to budget additional money to upgrade personal camping equipment and souvenirs. See personal gear list. Other possible costs include additional crew t-shirts and food for crew condition hikes.

Philmont is not risk free and you should be prepared to listen to safety instructions carefully, follow directions and take appropriate steps to safeguard yourself and others. Scouts must be at least First Class before attending. The Philmont Committee selects adult participants based upon adult to youth participation ratio, Scouting background and BSA Policy. All participants must be a registered member of the Boy Scouts of America.
