



Frontier District Spring Camporee "Wilderness Living"

WHEN: APRIL 27th – 29th, 2012
WHERE: Camp Sinoquipe, Fort Littleton, PA
COST: \$10 PER PERSON, YOUTH & ADULT

Units must register for the event by April 2nd. Individuals may be added to the troop roster after this date. However no unit may register after the deadline of April 2nd. The \$10 fee covers the participant patches, rental of Camp Sinoquipe and Camporee event fees. **Please fill out the attached registration form with payment and forward to the council office or email Kevin Gill at kevin.gill@scouting.org.**

Registration: The Spring Camporee will be held at Camp Sinoquipe by Fort Littleton, PA. Since this camporee is out of council, Troops will need to complete and submit a Tour Plan

(http://www.scouting.org/filestore/pdf/680-014_fillable.pdf) and submit it to the council office at least 21 days before the Camporee.

Registration will begin at Camp Sinoquipe at 6:00 PM. Troops can register any time after 6:00 PM, and will be given directions to their troop camp location.

Medical Information: All attendees of the Camporee will need to bring copies of their Medical Forms to provide to the medical staff for the weekend. Troops will be expected to provide first aid for minor injuries (cuts, scrapes, etc.). All major injuries will be taken care of by the Medical Staff at the Wells Valley Lodge.

Camping: Each troop will be responsible for providing their own tents, dining flies and all necessary camping equipment. Ground fires are not permitted except in designated fire rings. Above ground fires are permitted in above ground containers. Troops will need to provide their own firewood for the weekend. Remember to leave no trace!

Restrooms: There will be various restroom facilities available during the camporee. There are latrines available in the Rappahanock campsite, behind Wells Valley Lodge, the guest restrooms, and two port-a-johns by the Camping Areas. **Water will be available at various locations in Camp. Please keep these facilities clean!!**

Dining: Each Troop will be responsible for providing its own meals throughout the weekend. Saturday night will be a one-pot luck meal for all of the Troops and Staff to come together and eat. Each Troop will need to bring their favorite one-pot meal (chili, beef stew, pasta, etc...) to share with the Camporee. Each troop will need to provide their own beverages for themselves at the meal. Each troop will need to provide their own eating implements (plates, cups, silverware, etc) at the pot luck. **Troops will need to transport their shared meal to the Hope Pavilion next to the dining hall. Please bring your camp chairs to the meal as there is not enough seating at the pavilion for all attendees.**

SPL Meeting: There will be a meeting of the SPL from each Troop Friday evening at 9:30 PM. At the meeting, you will be given your station assignments for Saturday.

Adult Cracker Barrel: There will be a cracker barrel hosted by the Frontier District Commissioners Friday night at 9:30 PM.

Activities: There will be 6 stations set up throughout Saturday, and each troop will rotate through the stations like a Klondike Derby. Each station will teach a different skill that will enable you to survive in a Wilderness Living situation. Stations will include skills like shelter making, primitive fire making, and other skills necessary to survive (**and thrive!**) in a Wilderness Living situation.

Evening Games: After the closing campfire, Wilderness Living staff will be available to come to your campsite and teach you a game utilizing some of the skills you learned throughout the day. **If your Troop is interested, please let one of the Wilderness Living Staff know!!**

Cancellation will only take place in the event of severe weather or unsafe conditions.

Conduct: Please remember that we are all Boy Scouts, and you are expected to be respectful of Camp Sinoquipe. The Mason-Dixon Council is gracious enough to host us, and we need to treat this Camp like it is our own!!!

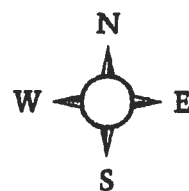

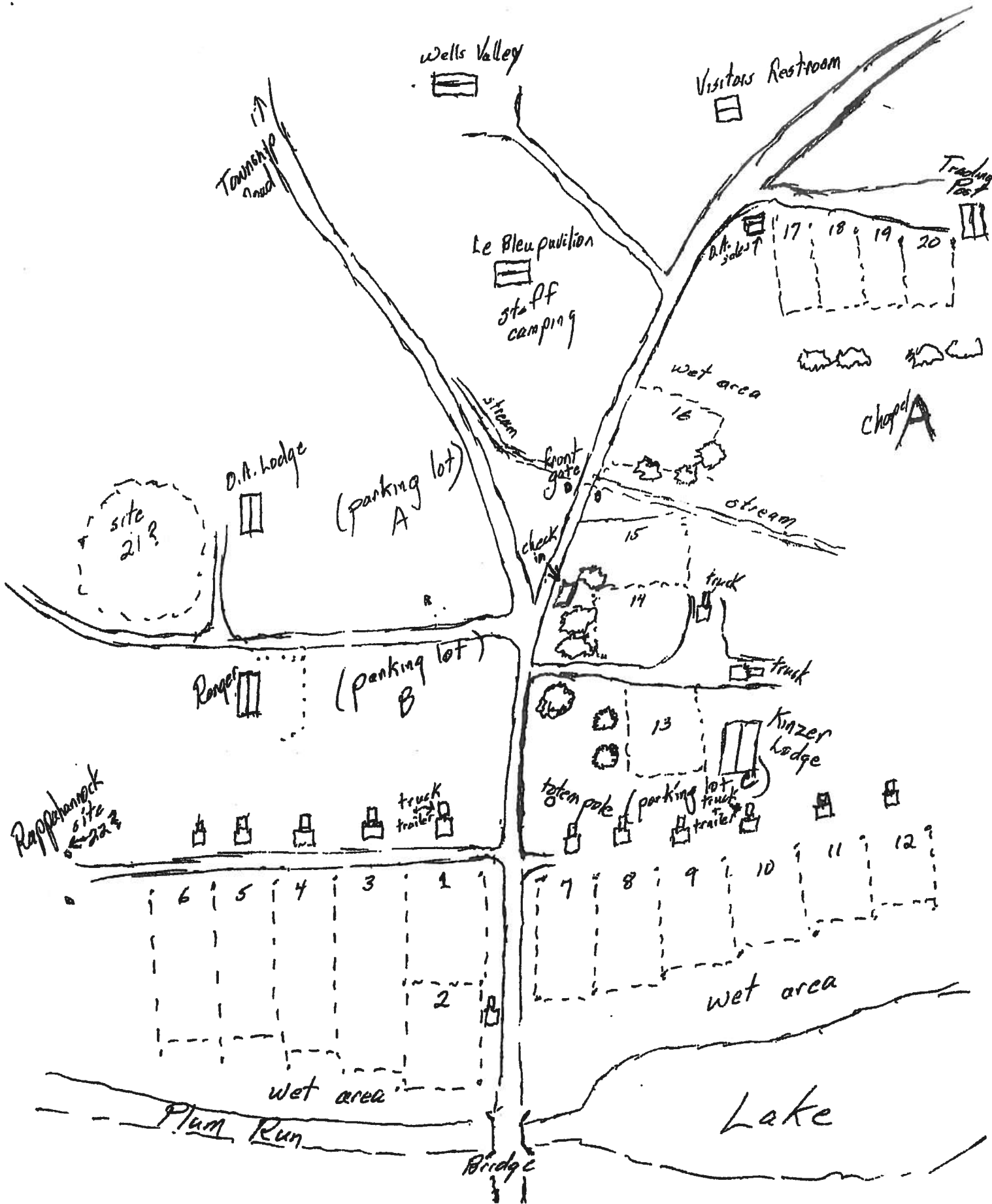
