Background Information:

The New Birth of Freedom Council, BSA is seeking to employ a resident Shooting Director at Hidden Valley Scout Reservation. NRA certification is offered in May and early June 2019. Summer employment will run through the end of July. All meals, housing and the cost of all additional training and certification is provided by the New Birth of Freedom Council.

Responsibilities of the Aquatics Director:

The Shooting Sports Director is responsible to the Program Director for the safe and effective instruction and management of the Shooting Sport Ranges of camp. The Shooting Sports Director must exercise mature, sound judgment and possess a high degree of personal integrity. Patience and a desire to work with male and female youth of Scout age are essential for the execution of the position.

Qualifications:

- Experience working with youth.
- Physical ability, proficiency, training and experience sufficient to meet the needs of shooting sports program.
- Experience training and managing shooting sports staff.
- Must be 21 years of age or older and become a registered adult member of BSA
- Must be able to attend National Camp School NRA Training and obtain certification.
- Must provide all required Pennsylvania child abuse clearance records

The Shooting Sports Director is further responsible for:

- Setting up, maintaining, and supervising shooting sports ranges, and meeting or exceeding applicable BSA standards and Pennsylvania state, local, and federal laws.
- Manage shooting sports staff, schedule and all shooting activity and advancement.
- Proper operation and general maintenance of shooting ranges and all equipment.
- Chief counselor for the shooting sports advancements responsible to certify and submit all records.
- Enforcing strict adherence to all established safety regulations.
- Training of the members of the shooting sports staff.
