CAMP SITES

Each unit will be given a camping assignment upon arrival. Units are responsible for camping area supplies. The Venturing Event will provide all meals so no kitchen materials are required except those mentioned below under UNIT REQUIREMENTS.

BSA REQUIREMENTS

Upon check-in, all leaders will sign-in, confirming that all paperwork is in order.

It is the leader's responsibility to have the following in their possession at the event:

Health and Medical Record

Each person registered, scouts and adults, must have a current completed and signed BSA Annual Health and Medical Record, Parts A and B. Part C is NOT required. This record is valid for 12 calendar months from when is signed. Unit Leaders are responsible to keep these forms.

Permission Forms

Unit Leaders is responsible for keeping the forms.

First Aid

We will have trained medical personnel on staff for this Venturing Event. However, each crew should be able to take care of minor injuries, and the Scouts should be carrying their own personal First Aid kits anyways. Injuries requiring medical attention should be reported to and attended by the medical personnel on staff. Please have proper medical forms with the crew for each person.

Youth Protections & Guide to Safe Scouting

We require that all persons attending this event follow all guidelines of Youth Protection and the Guide to Safe Scouting.

PA Background Clearances

All adults attending this event must provide the required background clearances required by their state. In PA that would include-Report of Criminal History from the Pennsylvania State Police, Child Abuse History Clearance from the Department of Human Services & Fingerprint based FBI criminal history clearance submitted through the Department of Human Services. Volunteers who have resided in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania for the past 10 years can submit a Disclosure Statement Application for Volunteers in place of the FBI fingerprinting. If you cannot provide proof of these requirements you must leave the event.

Unit members over 18 are not required to complete the PA Background clearances but must be registered as an adult with the BSA.

EVENT RULES AND PROCEDURES

A spirit of scouting courtesy and brotherhood must prevail during the entire event if it is to be a success. The scout oath, law and outdoor code are the guides for all behavior at this event. Units or individuals who do not conform to this spirit will be asked to leave the event.

1. A registration fee for each scout and scouter will be charged to cover the cost of the event supplies, awards and patches. Fees must have been paid in advance and prior to check-in at the event site.
2. Units should arrive and depart in their full “Class A” uniform.
3. Scouts should dress for Saturday activities in a manner that is appropriate for the activity and the weather. “Class B” uniform is recommended. Stations may be inside and outside.
4. Campsites and sleeping area will be pre-assigned by the event staff.
5. Safety and fire protection are the responsibility of everyone at this event.
6. Lights out will be at 11:00 P.M. Reveille will be at 7:00 AM. The camp is to be quiet during these hours. Please respect those who are camped around you.
7. Any unsafe or improper use of knives, axes or other tools will result in immediate removal from the event of the violator.
8. Sheath knives, butterfly and fixed blade scabbard knives are prohibited.
9. All meals will be provided. Please note any Food Allergies when registering.
