# General Information

## **Location**

This year's camporee is Newville Lions Club Fairgrounds also known as the Newville Fairgrounds 437 Shippensburg Rd, Newville, PA 17241.

**The Fairgrounds will be hosting a Tractor Pull on Saturday evening. The Scouts are welcome to watch the event and enjoy the fair stand foods that evening. If you are looking to enjoy the food stands for the evening please make certain to bring cash for the stands.**

## **Leaders Meeting**

A Leaders meeting will be held Friday evening after check in.

## **Patrol Size**

Each patrol should be made of between 4 and 8 Scouts. All events require complete Patrol participation. Some events may require repeat scout if patrol is less than 8.

## **Arrival / Check in Process**

All units will need to check in Friday night with event staff.

## **Bathroom Facilities**

Bathrooms are located on the far side of the facility opposite of the tenting area.

## **Garbage**

All units should plan to carry out everything that was carried in.

## **Parking**

**Parking is limited so please try to bring as few vehicles as possible.**

## **Buddy System**

Please remind all Scouts that the Buddy System should be used at all times. Campers should never travel alone.

## **First Aid**

Each unit should bring their own first aid kit. Any emergencies should be reported immediately either to one of the activity leaders or by calling the headquarters.

## **Prohibited**

Event staff reserves the right to confiscate any prohibited items or items felt to be unsafe from either campers or adults.
