### Health & Safety



## Check-In & Welcome Message

Check-in will take place starting 8:00 am at Wolf Hall. Scouts are expected to bring their minor waivers; we will have some on-hand for parents to sign in case they did not bring theirs. Scouts will receive a registration packet with a meal ticket, class location information, event patch, and wristband. Scouts will be expected to keep their wristbands on all day. Scouts participating in the Non-Merit Badge classes (STEM and Outdoor Leadership) will also receive a small gift.

A welcome message will be given in the Waldener Performing Arts Center Theater at 8:30 am. After the welcome message and announcements, Scouts will be dismissed to their classes. York College students will be on hand to guide Scouts to their merit badge sessions.
