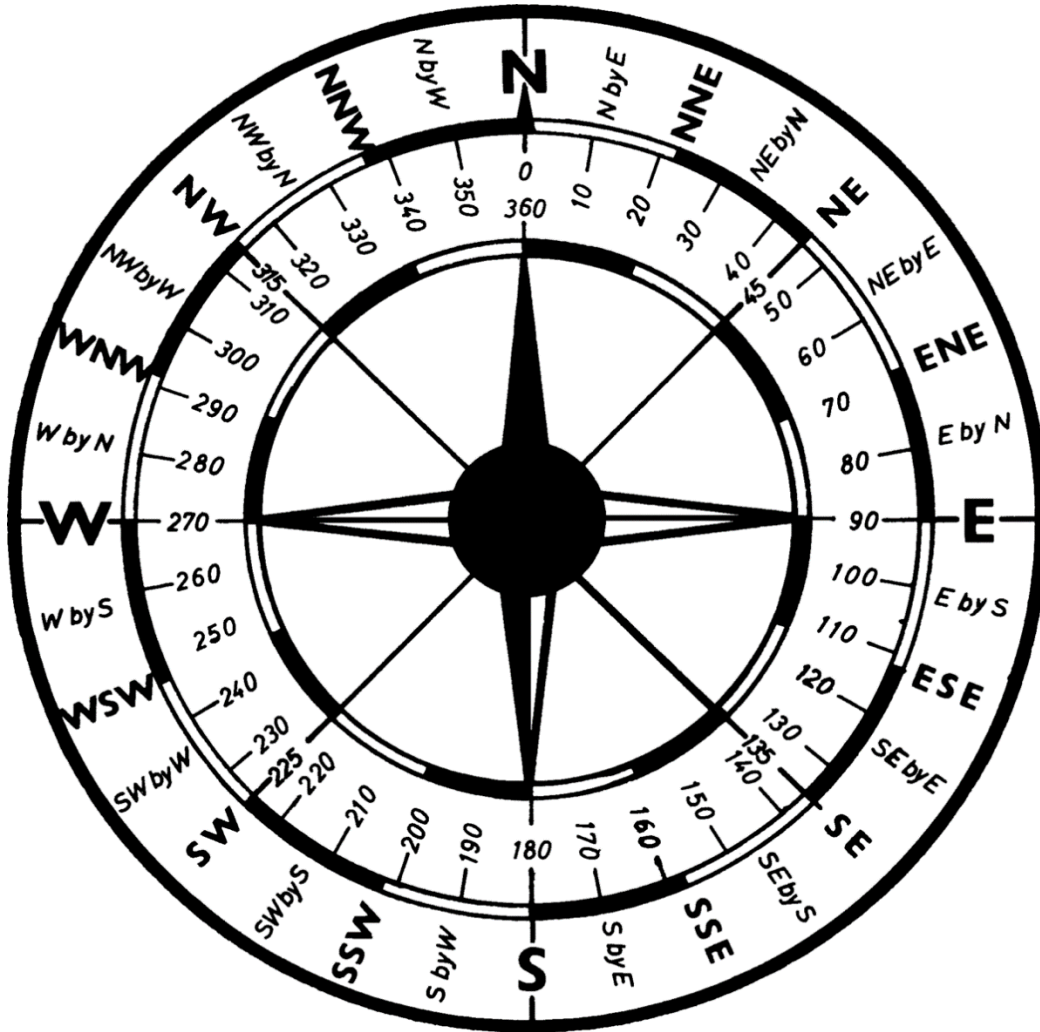

# **General Information**

## **Location**

This year's camporee is at Newville Lions Club Fairgrounds, 433 Shippensburg Rd, Newville, PA 17241

## **Patrol Size**

Each patrol should be made of between 4 and 8 Scouts. All events require complete Patrol participation. Some events may require repeat scout if patrol is less than 8.

## **Arrival / Check in Process**

All units will need to check in Friday night with event staff. Sign to mark registration area. **A leaders meeting will occur one week prior to the event to go over additional information about the event.**

## **Bathroom Facilities**

Latrines are located in the main building.

## **Garbage**

All units should plan to carry out everything that was carried in.

## **Parking**

**Parking in designated area only. One tow vehicle and trailer may remain at the Troop's campsite for the duration of the event.**

## **Prohibited**

Event staff reserves the right to confiscate any prohibited items or items felt to be unsafe from either campers or adults.

### **Prohibited:**

- Adult Participation.
- Fireworks
- Firearms
- Alcohol
- Tobacco use or possession by under-age individuals
- Ammunition
- Personal Communication Radios
- Laser Pointers
- Any other item determined to be unsafe

## **Buddy System**

Please remind all Scouts that the Buddy System should be used at all times. Campers should never travel alone.

## **First Aid**

Each unit should bring their own first aid kit. Any emergencies should be reported immediately either to one of the activity leaders or by calling the headquarters.

## **Additional rules**

- Open field camping only, no hammocks.
- No Ground fires permitted.
- Raised fire pits are permitted.
